## Catherine Washburn Medical Association: Helping Lopez Islanders for 53 years

Catherine Washburn Medical Association has been working to ensure ongoing medical care on Lopez since 1971. We raised the funds to build the Lopez Clinic in 1974, and funded its subsequent expansions and remodel. CWMA owns the clinic building and continues to purchase and maintain much of its equipment.

We have supported these additional health-related services since 2017:

Helping Lopez Island Physical Therapy with rent and equipment purchases.

Paying medical bills for those who need assistance.

Sponsoring vaccination clinics during the pandemic, purchasing a refrigerator for vaccines and materials to make free masks, and paying nurses' license renewal fees.

Helping Lopez Fire and Emergency Medical Services with equipment purchases.



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## UW Medicine Primary Care Lopez, Island Clinic

UW Medicine operates Lopez Island's primary care clinic in partnership with Catherine Washburn Medical Association (CWMA) and the Lopez Island Hospital District (LIHD).

Walk-in appointments are available every day that the clinic is open. Based on medical necessity, our clinical team helps determine the best care plan which may include a walk-in appointment, scheduled appointment, telemedicine (online video appointment) or other form of care.

Telemedicine appointments are available from 8 am - 8 pm, seven days a week from anywhere in Washington state. They are an excellent way to speak directly with a provider.

Speak with a nurse at Lopez Clinic during regular hours by calling the clinic at (360) 468-2245 x2 or by sending a MyChart message to the care team.

On-call nurses are available by phone 24-hours-a-day, seven days a week, 365 days a year. Call the clinic at (360) 468-2245 and follow the on-call nurse prompt.
